CT SCAN FOR BRAIN Report

FINDINGS:

TECHNIQUE: Serial axial sections of brain were made from base of skull to the vertex without contrast.

OBSERVATION:

No evidence of acute infarct or hemorrhage or space occupying mass lesion.

The gray white differentiation is maintained.

The basal cistern and superficial subarachnoid CSF spaces are normal.

The basal ganglia, thalami and capsular tracts appear normal.

Ventricular system normal for the age.

The cerebral hemisphere appear normal.

Cerebello pontine angles appear normal.

The midbrain, pons and medulla appears normal.

The bones of the cranium and pericranial soft tissue appear normal.

IMPRESSION:

No significant abnormality seen.

Note: Left maxillary sinusitis
